PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

As I sit down to write this, I'm just back from the Spring meeting of the National Bird Show Board of Directors. This Board is comprised of a group of people from across the United States who represent a number of clubs and a variety of birds. It's a long weekend and our only opportunity to meet as a group to plan the current years' event.

NBS, just like any other aviculture group, is faced with budget constraints and with trying to host an event that keeps as many people as possible happy within that budget. It's becoming increasingly difficult. There are changes this year, and we can expect more in the years to come, all necessary if this event is to continue and we all need to do our part to support this event in any way possible. As mentioned in prior years –that “support” may be in the form of a financial donation, an offer of help at the event, or perhaps placing an ad in the Show Catalog, etc. Is YOUR club affiliated with NBS? The NBS board has no choice but to make sure they don't SPEND more than they MAKE; so if you attend the event and see changes– please remember this club, just like any other, is working with a limited budget.

Some of you asked about NBS making disposable cardboard show cages available at the show. While the NBS is not in a position to purchase, store, or transport these cages, they “heard” your concerns about the cost of shipping your show cages to the show site and home again. As a result, they are working to find vendors who are able to make these available at the show site.

Some of you have also asked about the option of purchasing the electronic secretary sheets used at the National Event. This program is one the NBS purchased and is copy-righted. It is also being “tweaked” each year and considered to be in the “development” stage. The NBS Board did discuss this and felt, while it may be an option in the future, they do not feel it's a product yet worthy of marketing and sales efforts at this time. If and when it's made available for re-sale, they want to make sure it's the best product possible and you can be assured your money was well spent.

One change you will notice this year, at least for those of you who pre-register, is the packet mailed to you will not include the Show Catalog. The board felt the increasing costs of postage for mailing the catalog was becoming cost prohibitive. As a result, your catalog will be available in your Exhibitor

Successful Breeding of Peter Twinspots

HISTORY OF THE PAIR

At the end of September 2016, I acquired Peters Twinspots from an importer in South Africa. This was from the last birds imported before the ban started. The age of my pair is thus unknown. The cock was paired with another female which I subsequently lost. In April I introduced another hen and they immediately started breeding. I miss interpreted their behaviour for abandonment during May 2017, and when a chick fledged, it was very weak due to poor nutrition provided by me. The chick died the first night out of the nest.

During June 2017 the hen got egg bind, and I gave her heat. She didn't recover enough to be able to push the egg out and was basically dead. As a last resort I broke the egg inside her and was fortunate that she recovered 100%. I didn't return her to the cock, but separated them for the remainder of the winter.

She was re-introduced to the cock early September, and they started building a nest within a week. Breeding started shortly after.



GEOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION

I am located 30km outside Malmesbury in the Western Cape, we have dry hot summers, and cool/cold wet winters. We have a lot of wind, summer south-east, and winter west and north-west.

AVIARY INFORMATION

I have a breeding setup, meaning my aviaries are small with limited birds and species per aviary. Aviaries are 0.9m wide, 1.8 deep, and 2.1m high. The Peters Twinspots do not have a densely planted aviary, some grass and shrubs and additional cover is provided.

They share their aviary with one pair of Gouldian finches.

Seed mixture is provided by means of roof hanging self-feeders, and soft food, minerals and water are given on a feed platform from the outside, I thus enter the aviary the least amount of times possible (only to fill the self-feeders).

Nesting sites provided included large hollow bricks, and a piece of cloth hanging from the side of the aviary (was meant to plug a hole but they built their nest under it!)

Nesting material includes teff grass, kikuyu grass, and feathers.

NUTRITION PROVIDED

I have a 2-week water routine:

Week 1: Monday	Vitation 34
Tuesday	Clean water
Wednesday	Apple cider vinegar
Thursday	Clean water
Friday	Clean water
Saturday	Apple cider vinegar
Sunday	Clean water

Week 2: Monday	Vit B12
Tuesday	Clean water
Wednesday	Vit D3 and Calcium Boro Gluconate
Thursday	Vit D3 and Calcium Boro Gluconate
Friday	Vit D3 and Calcium Boro Gluconate
Saturday	Clean water
Sunday	Apple cider vinegar

The Vit D3 and Calcium Boro Gluconate is specifically to combat egg bind, since I start this routine I have not experienced egg bind again.

Seed Mix *(always available in self feeders):*

- 30% white millet
- 20% budgie mix
- 40% red manna
- 10% canary

Soft Food:

- Boiled pigeon breeding mix
- Sprouted mung beans and shelled sunflower
- Broccoli
- Green beans
- Carrot

These ingredients are chopped fine in a food processor. I then add hard-boiled egg and sprouted Japanese millet.

Live Food:

- Black soldier fly maggots and mealworms



BEHAVIOUR OF BIRDS

The hen and cock shared brooding. Three days before my estimated hatch date I started to increase the amount of live food provided.

The pair tried to indicate that they don't even have a nest, and would never approach their nest while I am in site. I thus always spend as little time as possible at the aviary. The amount of food they ate gave them away however. Some days I had to top up the live food, and other days I had to top up their soft food.

On day 12 the hen stopped sleeping in the nest.

On day 20 the chicks fledged.

CARE GIVEN TO CHICKS

The first night out all the chicks returned to the nest. The second night the 2 strongest perched for the evening, and the 2 weakest chicks returned to the nest. The weather was cold and windy, as such I took the two chicks that perched inside for the night (in a Gouldian nestbox).

The following evening all the chicks perched and the weather was favourable, and subsequently I have left them alone.
